
The American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP) is a membership association of more than 540,000 US composers, songwriters, lyricists and music publishers of every kind of music. Through agreements with affiliated international societies, they also represent hundreds of thousands of music creators worldwide. ASCAP is the only US performing rights organization created and controlled by composers, songwriters and music publishers, with a Board of Directors elected by and from our membership. ASCAP protects the rights of their members by licensing and distributing royalties for the non-dramatic public performances of their copyrighted works.

The Dramatists Guild of America is the professional association of playwrights, librettists, lyricists and composers writing for the American stage. Originally formed as a sub-committee of the Author's League in 1915, and later established as an independent organization in 1919, The Guild was created to advocate on behalf of dramatists, to protect the artistic and economic integrity of their work, and to foster and cultivate their community, enabling them to hand down their unique craft to the dramatists yet to come. Through its services, educational programs and advocacy, the Dramatists Guild works to ensure that theater in America will continue to flourish and that the unique voices which give it life will continue to reflect and celebrate the richness and diversity of the American experience.

ASCAP Presents: Celebrating Stephen Schwartz

STEPHEN SCHWARTZ served as President of the Dramatists Guild from 2009-2015. His theater credits include the music and lyrics for the current Broadway hit *Wicked*, as well as music and/or lyrics for *Godspell*, *Pippin*, *The Magic Show*, *The Baker's Wife*, *Working* (which he also adapted and directed), *Rags*, *Children Of Eden* and *The Hunchback of Notre Dame*. He collaborated with Leonard Bernstein on the English texts for Bernstein's *Mass* and wrote the title song for the play and movie *Butterflies Are Free*. For children, he has written songs for two musicals, *Captain Louie* and *My Son Pinocchio*. His opera, *Séance on a Wet Afternoon*, was produced at Opera Santa Barbara and New York City Opera. A book about his career, *Defying Gravity*, has recently been released by Applause Books. Mr. Schwartz has been inducted into the Theatre Hall of Fame. www.stephenschwartz.com.

MICHAEL KERKER (moderator) has been Director of Musical Theatre for ASCAP (American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers) since 1990. Michael is also producing a regular series of interview programs entitled "Broadway: Up Close and Personal" for the Kennedy Center. Michael's onstage conversations with some of our nation's most prominent songwriters have included evenings with Jerry Herman, Alan and Marilyn Bergman, Charles Strouse, Sheldon Harnick, Marvin Hamlisch, and Stephen Schwartz.
